



HMB Regulation and Requirements Helmets Greathelm

The Great Helm was an **additional** horsemen's helmet. Sources show an absence or very small number of decorative or breath holes on left side of the helmet. Visor holes are thin. It was worn as the second helmet to bascinets with chainmail or scale aventails.

Requirements to use Great Helms in HMB: :

- They should follow the measures and proportions of Great Helms
- They should follow requirements for decorative, breath and visor holes.
- They should be used only with chainmail or scale gorgets.

Sugarloaf helm

- •Used before 1350.
- •They should be used only with chainmail or scale gorgets.

Griffon helmet

Griffon-bascinet helmets are permitted.

Griffon topfhelm should follow the source: shape of the dome and the visor holes. It should be worn with chainmail or scale gorgets.






